Purpose

This standard provides framework for grading and grade scales at the college as well as for official transcripts.

Definitions

<u>Course</u>: one course of the program which is required to achieve a regulated certification, or consideration for completion of a college defined program.

<u>Credit:</u> the number of units of academic value assigned to a course.

<u>Cumulative GPA (CGPA)</u>: the total sum of grade points received during the period of a student's enrollment divided by the number of credits attempted during that period.

<u>Cumulative Credits:</u> The total number of credits earned for all courses completed at the college.

<u>GPA:</u> Grade Point Average. The total sum of grade points received during a semester of a student's enrollment divided by the number of credits attempted during that period.

<u>Grading Scale</u>: Describes how grades are assigned according to different categories including percentage grade and letter grades. These descriptors are used to calculate a student's GPA

<u>Program:</u> the complete set of all courses required to achieve a regulated certification, or the collection of courses defined as a program by the college.

Statement

Ridge Meadows College follows national and provincial industry best practices for recording and transcripting grades and other elements of a student's academic record as per recommendations by the Association of Registrars of the Universities and Colleges of Canada (ARUCC) and the BC Transcript Maintenance Plan, facilitated by the Ministry of Advanced Education.

RMC transcripts include the following:

- Credit value of each course in which the student was registered;
- Number of credits earned for each course in which the student was registered;



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- Final letter grade or notation for each course in which the student was registered;
- Term grade point average (GPA) earned;
- Total number of credits earned in each term;
- Cumulative grade point average (CGPA) earned for all courses in which the student has registered; and
- Cumulative credits earned for all courses in which the student has registered.

Only grades for courses undertaken at RMC will be calculated into the term and cumulative GPA. Grades for transfer credits from other institutions will not be applied to GPA calculations. No grades will be recorded or calculated towards GPAs for credits earned through Prior Learning Assessment (PLAR).

If a course is taken more than once, only the highest grade from the two attempts will be attributed towards the GPA. However, all grades including the credits and corresponding grade point values will appear on the student's record.

Credit for a course may only be applied once in the student's program.

Courses with Withdrawal notations do not count towards GPA calculations.

The Program Chair must approve any faculty grade submissions and requests to change a final grade after they have been submitted.

Official transcripts include all courses attempted by the student including those that are in progress.

Students' records are confidential and a transcript will only be printed or released upon the request of the student and after any requirement for fees have been met.

Grading Scale:

All final grades and GPAs on for-credit classes (with the exception of the ECE program) are calculated using the following scale. Different programs may require different CGPAs for successful completion of the program. Non-credit courses do not receive grade point values.
