- 1. This schedule is subject to change and the college reserves the right to modify or cancel courses.
- 2. Classes will not be held on September 30, October 13 & November 11 due to statutory holidays.
- 3. Students are required to purchase their own textbooks (except for students who are sponsored by an outside funder). Student textbook information is located on our website at https://rmcollege.sd42.ca/program/early-childhood-educator/.
- 4. Health, Safety & Nutrition The course will now be run in an asynchronous method, therefore it will not overlap any other courses that you need to register in. This course will run with no required instructor facetime. Students will be required to submit weekly assignments to demonstrate their learning. More information will be sent prior to the start of 5. Practicum Preparation consists of 28 hours plus 8 hours of observation and must be taken in the same semester as Practicum 1.
- 6. Students are only allowed to enroll in 1 practicum per semester.
- 7. Students MUST BE enrolled in and/or have completed all of the Tier requirements, prior to enrolling in the Practicum for that Tier.
- 8. ECE C students wishing to enroll for workplace practicums must apply prior to going out on their practicum. Information will be provided throughout the semester regarding the application procedure.
- 9. ECE Post Basic students practicums may be completed at a student's workplace if the centre meets the criteria.
- 10. All students registering in Practicum 2 and 3 must attend mandatory practicum information sessions, prior to going out on their practicum. Please see dates above.
- 11. In person classes must be attended in person no online option. Class attendance is mandatory.
- 12. Previous Ridge Meadows College students who are enrolling in post basic classes (Special Needs, Infant Toddler or Diploma program) must retake Child Growth & Development 1 and/or Child, Growth & Development 2 if these classes were completed prior to 2022 as the curriculum has changed significantly or can request a Prior Learning assessment and recognition as per the standard on the website. Students are also able to take a challenge test at the college at a cost of \$50 per challenge test.
